

### WEST MICHIGAN SHORELINE NATURALIST PROGRAM

The West Michigan Shoreline Naturalist Program was created to provide the basic information about our local environments, habitats, and species to give participants the essential background in ecology and conservation. All classes are held on Saturday's from 9:00 am - 1:00 pm and will be led by trained educators and/or conservation professionals.

These sessions will be taught in both indoor and outdoor settings. There will be a classroom time of 45 to 90 minutes with the remainder of time being in the field (rain or shine). The outdoor sessions will be led on foot in a wide variety of locations throughout Muskegon County. Since some of these locations may have steep or rough terrain, appropriate attire is recommended. Automobile transportation is necessary and carpooling from to the field location can be coordinated if needed.

All participants will be provided with a training notebook, materials and resources appropriate for study. Participants should wear appropriate clothing such as boots, hat, long pants, etc. A camera, hand lens, field guides and binoculars may also prove helpful on field walks.
